


- Max. 30 ECTS per semester (exception, no overlap of courses)

General information on living in GÖ

- Most shops are closed on Sundays & holidays
- Some places (e.g. restaurants, bars & Christmas markets) only take cash, but usually credit/ debit card is fine
- Public drinking is allowed, but not on public transportation



- Apply early!
 - E.g. Studentenwerk (dorms)
 - Wg-gesucht.de (shared flat or sublet)
 - “Kleinanzeigen” (sublet, flats)
 - Some hotels offer cheap accommodation at the start of the semester
 - Accommodation Service (international office)
- Be aware of scams!



- Deutschlandticket: regional transportation (busses, “slow” trains, not IC/ICE)
- “Supersparpreis”
- after 20 min delay, take any train
- after 60 min delay or if you never took the train -> get money back







Where cultures collide, creativity explodes! Come to the Theatre Workshop and have a great time!




